

# Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – DECEMBER 2021

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

## Project progress

The past year has seen some significant activities at Auchenflower station, with major milestones including the installation by crane of the new footbridge and lift infrastructure, raising sections of the platforms and the commencement of new station entrances.

We thank customers and the local community for your patience and understanding during these important steps in project delivery.

Works undertaken in November included:

- partial raising of platform 2/3
- continuing lift shaft installation
- footbridge and stair works
- excavation of lower station entrance, Auchenflower Terrace
- off-site fabrication of station building, walkway and platform shelters (ongoing).

## Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- ongoing lift installation
- installation of sections of pedestrian walkway infrastructure (by crane from Auchenflower Terrace)
- ongoing footbridge, stair and platform works.

Please take care around the work zones.



## Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- relocated ticketing equipment and platform facilities
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Auchenflower Terrace (between Dixon and Ridley Streets) will be closed to vehicles until 22 December 2021. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
