PROJECT UPDATE – MAY 2020

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

About the project

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade will deliver improved station facilities, including raised platforms at the assisted boarding point, a new footbridge, lifts and improved accessible parking, so all customers can travel without barriers.

Main construction is expected to commence in the second half of 2020.

Project progress

The following activities have been undertaken recently, in preparation for future construction:

- ongoing early works overhead infrastructure installation and modifications
- ongoing station upgrade design
- ongoing community engagement.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and community can expect to see the following activities:

- continuing early works
- overhead line infrastructure activities
- track works





Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
