

Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – OCTOBER 2022

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- opening of new ticket office
- fit-out of new pedestrian footbridge
- stormwater works (ongoing)
- platform works (ongoing), pictured right
- installation of station wayfinding signage
- continuing station entrance works – Auchenflower Terrace and Lang Parade
- removal of temporary ticket office
- construction of new bicycle facilities, station carpark and surrounding footpath works (ongoing), pictured below.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- continuing station entrance works – Auchenflower Terrace and Lang Parade
- opening on new footbridge (Lang Parade, near Chasely Street)
- closure of platform 1 (early November) for works, including resurfacing, paving and entry plaza flooring
- installation of station wayfinding signage
- construction of new bicycle facilities
- continuing station carpark and footpath works.

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed traffic conditions for safety
- temporary changes to access paths
- relocated ticketing equipment and facilities
- station carpark closed for construction
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).

Station carpark closure

The station's carpark will be closed until late November 2022 to facilitate upgrade works.
