# Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE - SEPTEMBER 2020

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

### **Project progress**


Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- underground services works
- removal of some existing structures and waiting shelters
- ongoing station upgrade design
- overhead line infrastructure wiring adjustments and some mast removal
- temporary relocation of bike lockers.

# **Upcoming works**

In the coming weeks, the following activities will be undertaken:

- establishment of contractor's site facilities
- removal of remaining platform waiting shelters
- relocation of ticketing equipment platform 2/3
- overhead line mast removal and signalling activities (night works).





### **Construction impacts**

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
