

Morayfield station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – DECEMBER 2019

The Morayfield station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's \$357 million investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

The following activities were undertaken at Morayfield in November:

- removal of temporary facilities – eastern pathway (Caboolture-end)
- demolition of eastern pathway (Caboolture-end)
- completion of footpath upgrade – platform 2
- ongoing lift installation
- ongoing western entry works.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- station entrance works – fencing and railings
- ongoing lift installation
- bicycle enclosure construction – roofing
- installation of bus shelter and associated works
- landscaping works.

Please follow all directional signage and take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to station access paths
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Residents and the local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).

We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we work to improve your station.

Project activities will shut down briefly over the Christmas period. Works will resume in early January 2020.
