

Morayfield station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JUNE 2019

Queensland Rail's Morayfield station accessibility upgrade is part of the program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Activities undertaken recently at Morayfield have included:

- work on the new footbridge footings
- construction of station building slab
- installation of underground services – platform 2
- construction of lift shaft walls
- construction of new station building outer walls
- construction of lift shaft segments and footbridge (offsite)
- installation of new footbridge during track closure, early June (pictured).

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- ongoing construction of the new station building
- install station building roofing
- concreting – back of platform raising
- underground service pathways.

Please take care around the work zones.

Construction impacts

Normal working hours are 6am to 5pm Monday to Saturday. Construction activities may involve:

- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to station access paths
- changed traffic and parking conditions
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Residents and the local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights and Sundays, as required).
