## Night works – temporary ticket office removal

## 1am Wednesday 12 October 2022

As part of the Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will remove the temporary ticket office from site **from approximately 1am on Wednesday 12 October 2022**. Works are expected to take approximately one hour.

For safety, these works have been scheduled outside of timetabled rail services when there are fewer people around the station precincts.

During this time, cross-corridor pedestrian access will be via the station subway on lower Auchenflower Terrace.

Residents near the station may experience noise associated with the operation of a crane and truck movements. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these important works.
