## Night and after hours works

## May 2022

As part of the Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake **after hours** works on selected nights in May.

For safety, these works can only be undertaken after hours when rail traffic is reduced and there are fewer people around the station or hospital precincts.

Some night activities are a continuation of activities previously notified or already commenced. These include upgrading the pedestrian crossing on Lang Parade and abutment works for the new footbridge to be installed in May.

Around-the-clock weekend works will be undertaken during a scheduled track closure from 6pm Friday 20 until 6am Monday 23 May.

Lane closures and traffic management in Lang Parade (near the work zones), may be required to support deliveries, concrete trucks and construction activities.

Residents near the station may experience noise associated with trucks movements and construction activity. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these important works.
