Night works – concreting and associated activities

November 2022

As part of the Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake afternoon concrete pours on selected dates in November. Following these concrete pours, associated activities will be undertaken between 6pm and midnight on **Thursday 10, Monday 21, Tuesday 22 and Wednesday 23 November**, weather and construction conditions permitting.

These works have been scheduled depending on available concrete supplies and delivery windows.

To support site access and concrete pumping, localised lane closures and traffic management may be in operation at times on these dates. Motorists are requested to follow the instructions of the traffic controllers and drive to the changed conditions.

Residents near the station may experience noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these important works.
