Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade



Weekend works (during track closure)

Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 November 2022

Queensland Rail will undertake weekend works, associated with the Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade on **Saturday 26 and Sunday 27 November, 6am to 6pm each day** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Activities include the demolition and removal of the pedestrian ramp between platform 1 and the Barrack Road level crossing. Following these works, all access to and from platform 1 will be via the new footbridge stairs and lifts.

For safety, these works have been planned during a scheduled track closure when there is no rail traffic and there are fewer people around the station precinct.

A section of the station's northern carpark will be unavailable during the weekend's activities. The station's footbridge (and lifts) will be available for cross-corridor pedestrian access.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with demolition works and activities throughout the precinct. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these important works.

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Accessible features (footbridge with lifts, raised platforms) and new bicycle facilities opened earlier this year. In early 2023, works will commence on modifications to the station building and customer amenities.
