

Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE – JANUARY 2021

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress

The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- installation of remaining screw piles on both station platforms
- footbridge and lift foundation works behind platform 2 and in the northern carpark
- bulk excavation of the new footbridge and lift shaft footings
- ongoing design of the station upgrade.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- detailed excavation of the new footbridge, lift, roof and stair footings
- installation of pavers on the assisted boarding points of both platforms
- installation of the lift shaft and footbridge foundations
- lift shaft works - including waterproofing, drainage and retaining walls.



Construction impacts

During the station upgrade, changes due to construction activities may include:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- the use of mobile lighting towers (for night works).

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notice of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
