Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE - JULY 2021

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress

The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- modifications to overhead lines and removal of steel masts
- demolition of old stair and footbridge footings
- installation of platform one canopy and roof sheeting to platform two canopy
- demolition of the station entrance near the southern carpark
- in-ground stormwater works in the northern carpark.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- platform works including installation of tactile ground surface indicators
- installation of sheeting to platform one canopy
- ongoing modification works to the ticket window and station entrance
- ongoing lift shaft works
- retaining wall, footpath and ramp works at station entrance near the southern carpark
- preparatory works for bike enclosure construction, including installation of slab and electrical feeds.





Construction impacts

During the station upgrade, changes due to construction activities may include:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- the use of mobile lighting towers (for night works).

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notice of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
