Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE - MARCH 2022

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress

The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- installation of platform infrastructure and station signage (below left)
- finalisation of lift shaft works, including the opening of the three new station lifts (below middle)
- reinstatement of permanent fencing
- completion of carpark rectification works, including the opening of accessible car spaces in the park 'n' ride (below right).

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- defect rectification works
- station cleaning works

- painting and finishing works
- platform surfacing works
- removal of existing construction equipment and material within the station precinct
- removal of temporary fencing within the station precinct and along the freight corridor.
