Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE – OCTOBER 2021

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress

The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- completion of footpath in the northern park 'n' ride
- commenced installation of lift cars to lift shafts
- bike enclosure fit out and stormwater drainage
- installation of remaining slab on platform 1 in preparation for paving works
- completion of retaining wall at station entrance.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- paving works at the bottom of the footbridge stairs, lift shafts and remainder of both platforms
- installation of supporting lift equipment on platform 1 and in the northern park 'n' ride
- installation of concrete slabs at the back of platform 2 and the station entrance
- new kerb ramp to Barrack Road footpath at the northern park 'n' ride entrance
- installation of bike enclosure screens, platform canopy screens and platform canopy lights
- ongoing landscaping, bike enclosure, station entrance and lift shaft works.





Construction impacts

During the station upgrade, changes due to construction activities may include:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- the use of mobile lighting towers (for night works).

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notice of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
