

Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 2021

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress

The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- completion of ticket window modifications
- platform asphaltting and the installation of yellow line tactile pavers at the ends of Platforms 1 and 2
- preparatory works for new station entrance
- commencement of footpath concrete works in the northern park 'n' ride
- completion of inground pathways and installation of slab for the new bike enclosure (pictured right).

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- installation of platform infrastructure eg. seating/bins
- platform line marking and installation of signage
- landscaping around the station building and in the northern park 'n' ride
- construction of the bike enclosure in the northern park 'n' ride adjacent to Barrack Road
- finalisation of footpath in the northern park 'n' ride and concrete/paving works on both platforms
- ongoing station entrance and lift shaft works.



Construction impacts

During the station upgrade, changes due to construction activities may include:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- the use of mobile lighting towers (for night works).

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notice of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
