Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- fit-out of new ticket office (ongoing)
- platform works (ongoing)
- plumbing and electrical works
- bridge abutment works (new pedestrian footbridge)
- crane installation of new pedestrian footbridge, connecting Lang Parade and station carpark (pictured, below).

Upcoming works

In the coming months, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- continuing fit-out of new ticket office
- platform works including paving
- plumbing and electrical works
- fit-out of new footbridge and staircase screens
- station entrance works Auchenflower Terrace and Lang Parade
- station carpark ground works.

Please take care around the work zones.





Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed traffic conditions for safety
- temporary changes to access paths
- relocated ticketing equipment and facilities
- station carpark closed for construction
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
