

Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JULY 2021

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- footbridge foundation works (bored piling)
- ongoing stormwater works – platform 2/3
- fabrication of new footbridge (off-site)
- establish temporary road closure, Auchenflower Terrace (28 June to 29 October).

Upcoming works

In the next month, the following activities will be undertaken:

- excavation of lower station entrance, Auchenflower Terrace
- continuing platform activities
- footbridge footings/foundations
- concrete pour, footbridge column – platform 2/3
- preparation of crane pads and crane assembly
- delivery and assembly of new footbridge and lift shaft components
- installation of new footbridge by large crane (during weekend track closure 24 and 25 July)
- construction of lift shaft and stairs – platform 2/3 (during weekend track closure 24 and 25 July).

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- relocated ticketing equipment and platform facilities
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

To support major construction activities, Auchenflower Terrace will be closed to through traffic, between Dixon Street and Ridley Street, until Friday 29 October 2021. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
