

Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – NOVEMBER 2022

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- flooring surface works, Lang Parade entry plaza
- opening of new footbridge (Lang Parade, near Chasely Street) – pictured, right
- platform 1 resurfacing and paving
- installation of station wayfinding signage
- structural work, bicycle enclosure – pictured, below
- ongoing station carpark and footpath works.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- continuing station entrance works – Auchenflower Terrace and Lang Parade
- continuing construction of new bicycle facilities
- continuing station carpark works – asphaltting, kerbing and linemarking
- footpath reinstatement
- landscaping throughout the station precinct.

Please take care around the work zones.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed traffic conditions for safety
- temporary changes to access paths
- relocated ticketing equipment and facilities
- station carpark closed for construction
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday. The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).

Station carpark closure

The station's carpark will be closed until late November 2022 to facilitate upgrade works.
