Works involve setting up safety bollards and flag bunting on the platform to define the work zone in preparation for the following week's closure of platform 4.

For safety, these works have been scheduled outside of timetabled rail services when there are no trains operating.

While there will be no powered tools or equipment in use, residents near the station may experience noise associated with the presence of personnel around the station precinct.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience during these activities.
