## Night and after hours works - timber footbridge removal

### Saturday 29 to Monday 31 May 2021

As part of the Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake night and after hours works from **Saturday 29 to Monday 31 May** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Works will involve the removal of the old timber footbridge. For safety, these works have been scheduled over a track closure weekend when there is no rail traffic and the overhead power is switched off. On **Saturday 29** and **Sunday 30 May** the station and footbridge will be temporarily closed and buses will replace trains.

Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activity, the operation of cranes and heavy machinery, and the movement of trucks and vehicles around the work zone.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we build you a better Cannon Hill station.

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessibile for all customers.
