Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – MARCH 2022

The Auchenflower station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

Works recently undertaken at Auchenflower include:

- establishment of a temporary ticket office
- demolition works in preparation of old station building/concourse removal
- establishment of a large crane for building removal
- continuing fit-out of new footbridge, walkway and ticket office, platform works and lift installation.

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- structural/roofing works Lang Parade entrance
- removal of old station building/concourse by large crane (during track closure, 19 and 20 March)
- fit-out of new footbridge, walkway and ticket office
- removal of old pedestrian ramps
- platform raising and paving of remaining sections
- installation of new pedestrian footbridge to replace the existing concourse (mid-2022).

Temporary stair-only access to platforms

Following the removal of the old station building/concourse, the new footbridge will open for customers on Monday 21 March. Due to recent flood impact and ongoing lift installation, access to the platforms via the new footbridge will be stair-only for approximately two months.

Auchenflower customers requiring the use of lifts or ramps should use Milton station and seek assistance from staff. A free accessible shuttle will operate every 15 minutes between Auchenflower and Milton stations.





Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- relocated ticketing equipment and platform facilities
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).

To enable works, Auchenflower Terrace will be closed to vehicles until Saturday 2 April.

Please take care around the work zones.
